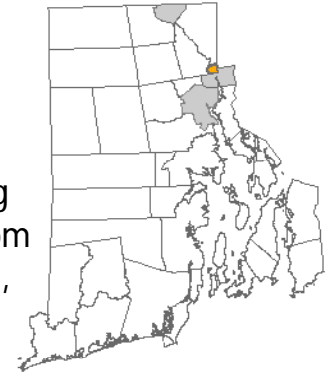
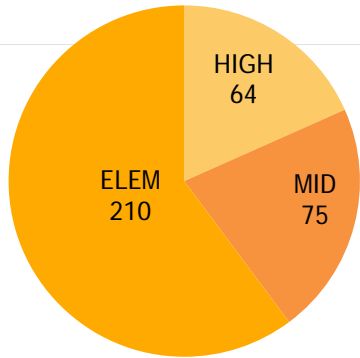

Moves Across Districts by Grade Level



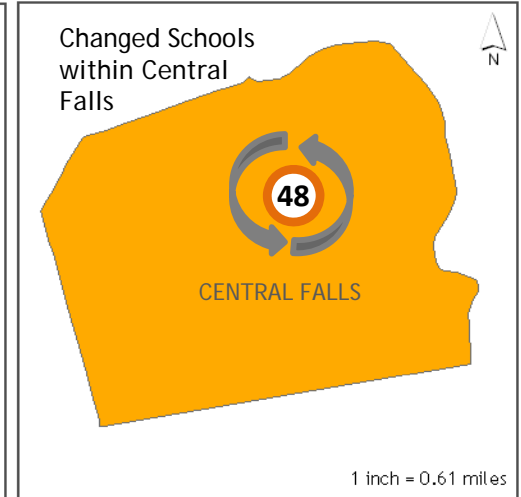
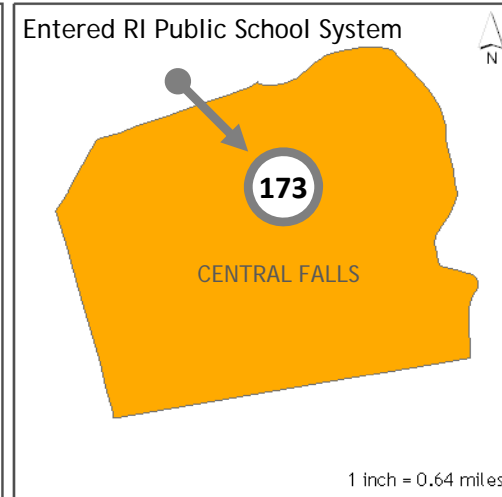
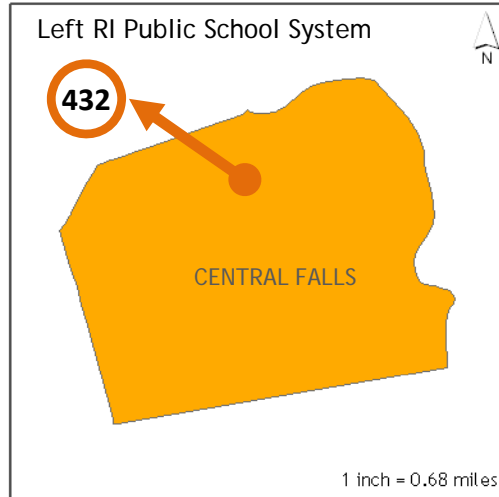
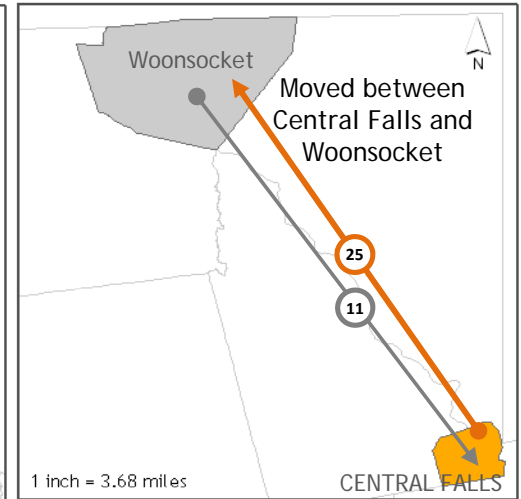
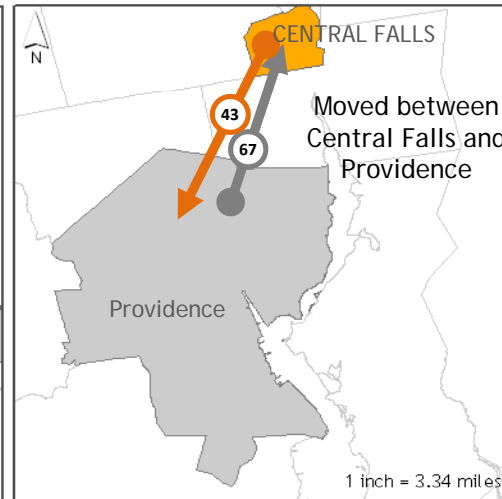
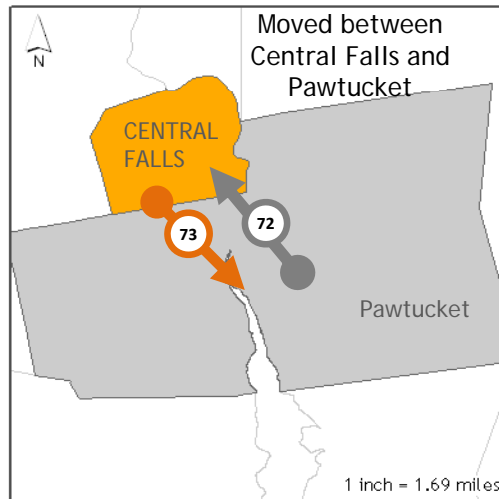

Moves Across Districts by Grade Level



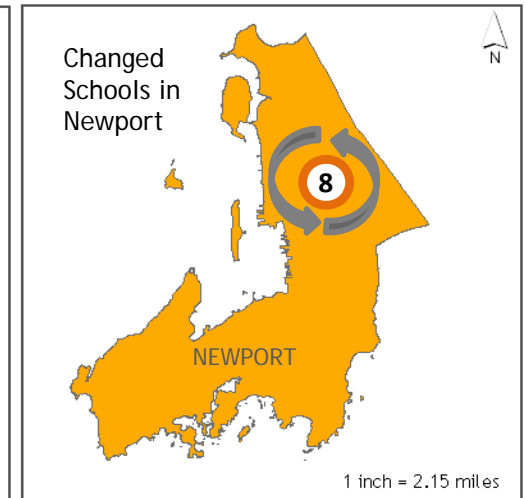
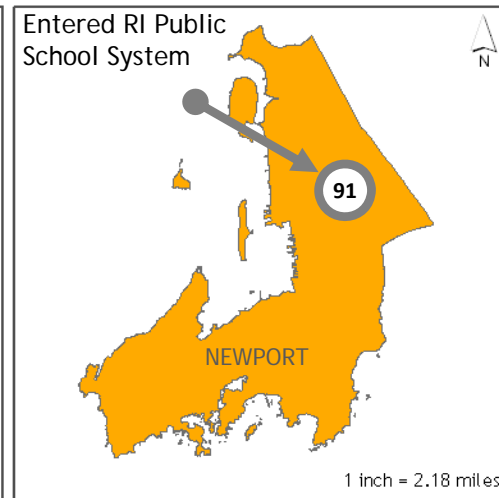
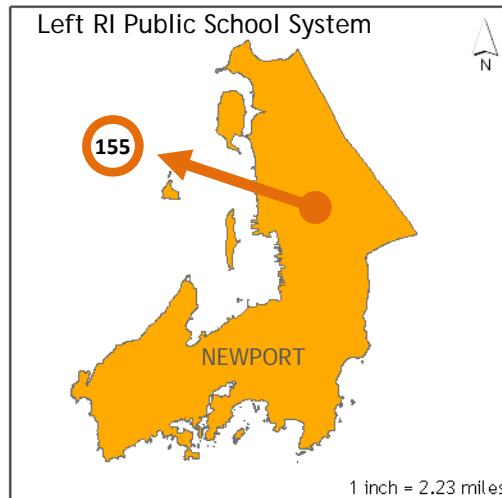
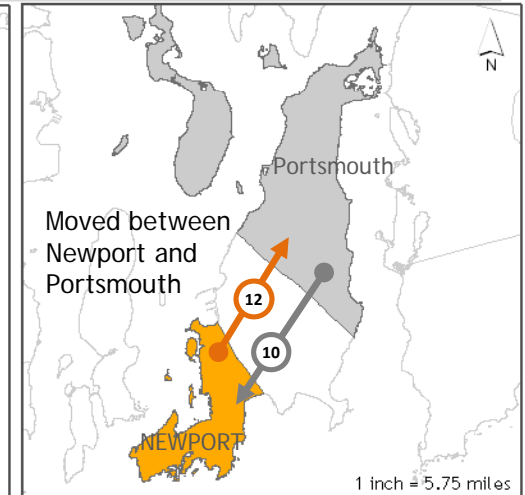
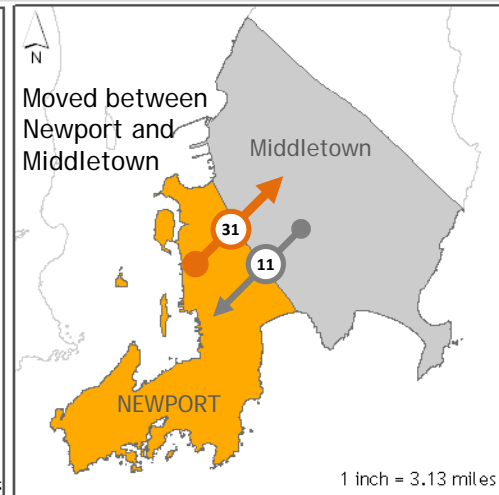
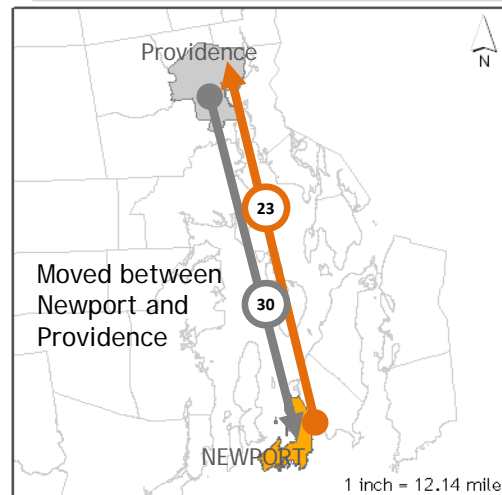

Moves Across Districts by Grade Level



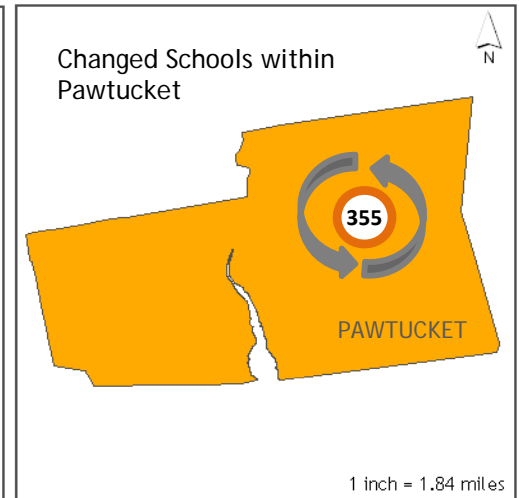
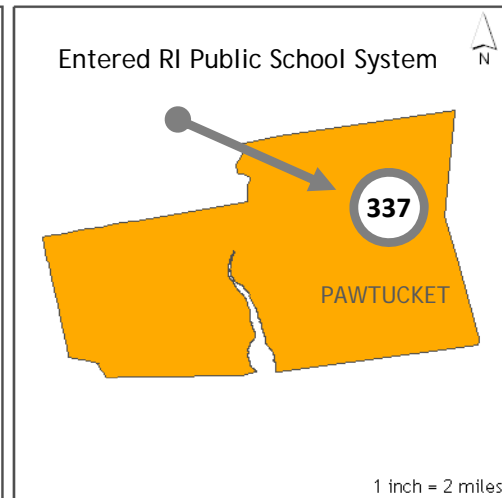
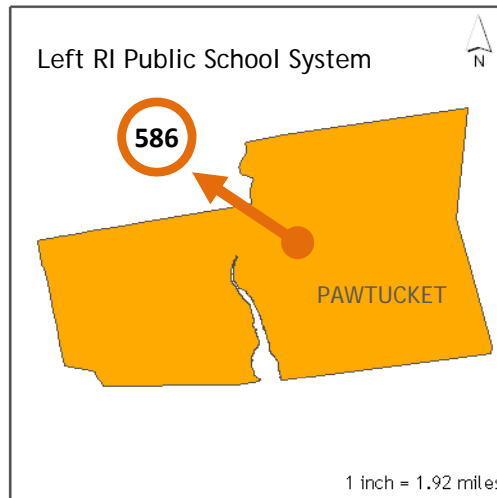
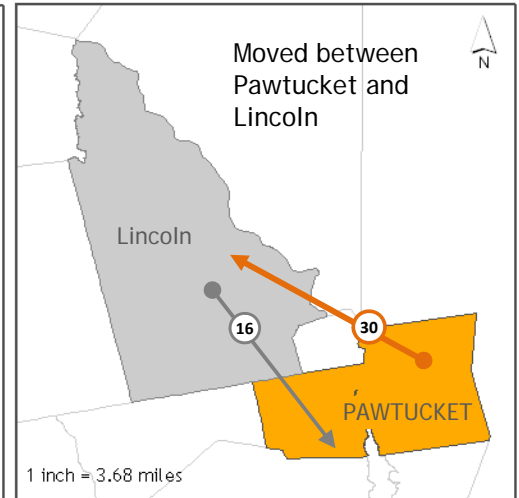
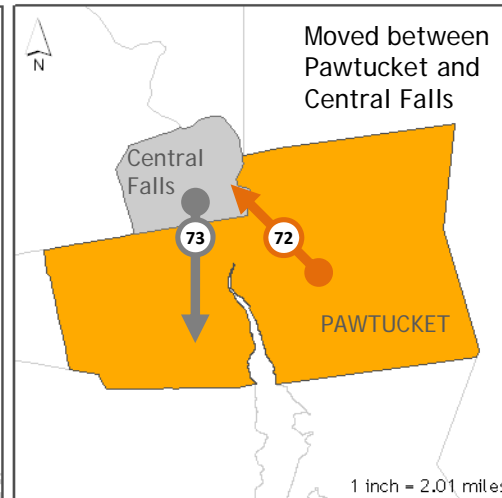
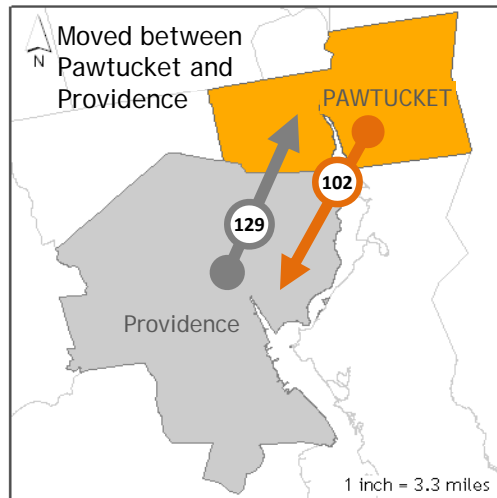

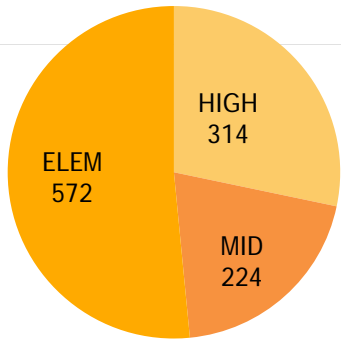
